

CONFERENCE / ROUNDTABLE

ENTRY CONDITIONS

Participation in the conference/roundtable is allowed under the Protective Measure of the Ministry of Health (MZDR 14601/2021-23/MIN/KAN), which allows such participation to persons who do not show clinical signs of the Covid-19 disease and meet one of the following conditions:

- a) the person has passed an RT-PCR test for SARS-CoV-2 virus with a negative result (can be proved by a confirmation of the performed test) no more than 72 hours ago, or
- b) the person has passed no more than 24 hours ago a rapid antigen test (RAT) for the presence of the SARS-COV-2 virus antigen with a negative results (can be proved by a confirmation of the performed test, or by a confirmation from an employer, by a confirmation from a school in case the person participated in the testing at school, or by a statutory declaration), or
- c) the person has been vaccinated against COVID-19 and at least 14 days have elapsed since the completed vaccination schedule (can be proved by a paper-based or electronic confirmation), or
- d) the person has a laboratory confirmation of having suffered the COVID-19 diseased in the past, no more than 180 days ago (can be proved by a doctor's confirmation of the suffered disease, confirmation of a positive RT-PCR test, or confirmation of the presence of antibodies).

Compliance with the conditions can be proved by **any paper-based or electronic document commonly recognised** under the protective measures of the Ministry of Health, or by a statutory declaration. This is only an brief informative overview of the conditions, the full text of the conditions is available in the Protective Measure of the Ministry of Health.

The guests can prove the compliance with the conditions for participation in the conference/roundtable by showing one of the above-mentioned confirmations to the authorised MUP staff.
